



From the Session

The Session met on March 17, 2020 for its regular Stated Meeting. The following are the high-lights from that meeting:

- 1. Marie Creed was received as a new member.
- 2. Due to COVID-19, Mike suggested that we limit committee reports to those requiring action by the Session.
- 3. The number required for a quorum at Session Meetings was increased to 9 members.
- 4. David Dundee and Nancy Kelly were appointed as the Session representatives to serve on the 2020 Officer Nominating Committee.
- 5. Worship Services and all inside-the-building activities with the exception of Friendship Table were suspended through 4/3/2020 due to COVID-19. Friendship Table worker volunteers will prepare food in the kitchen and will deliver take-out meals to guests outside the building Effective 3/17/2020 so no meals will be served inside the building.
- 6. The Session is working on a response to COVID-19 that will include (1) Practical Matters, (2) Prayer Matters, and (3) Provision for Spiritual Care and Leathership.
- 7. Through 2/29/2020, revenues were \$86,968 and expenses \$107,842 resulting in a budget shortfall of \$20,874.
