## We're Going Back To School



Tuesday, September 1, 2020

Dear Church Family,

Our Pre-School is doing its absolute best to open this fall. While waiting for the City Schools to make some decisions, we pushed back our starting date once they did. We did not want to open the same week as the school system; thus, we moved our first day to Tuesday, September 1.

We have been studying the CDC guidelines and the State guidelines for pre-schools. We will have these mailed to parents soon and post these in the pre-school area.

**Just a few highlights of these guidelines are as follows:**

1. Children will be screened each morning and then escorted to their classrooms. Temperatures will be taken.
2. Parents will not be allowed in the building except for Open House and emergencies.
3. Teachers and students will not wear masks during the school day. Adults may wear masks/shields during drop off and pick up.
4. Students will not leave their classrooms except for bathroom breaks and outside play.
5. Chapel and Music will be held in the classrooms to limit movement. Our science teacher will move to each class.
6. Cloth toys will not be allowed. This means no dress- up clothes.
7. We will wipe down all toys, tables, and countertops each day.

We appreciate all prayers as we try to accommodate while keeping safety top priority for these darling children.
