"I have been with you wherever you went."
2 Samuel 7:9

The third Sunday of Advent offers us this glimpse of a less familiar book from the Old Testament,

2 Samuel (2 Samuel 7:1-16). At first it seems like a very unusual lectionary (recommended) reading for the Advent season. It begins with a conversation between Nathan, the prophet, and King David. The king wants to build a house for God! But God has other plans. God assures David that there is no need for a specific house to be built for God. Rather, God says, "I have been with you wherever you went. . . . I will give you rest .... I will make you a house." How often do we try to build a house, a box, or expectations for God? In this very different Advent season, perhaps we can pause and consider how God is with us wherever we go (or don't go, if we are guarantined). Our lives rarely turn out how we plan or expect, and this year, needless to say, everything has been turned on its head! But, God is with us. God is with us because Christ came into the unpredictable, uncontrollable mess of our very human lives, to live with us, be with us, and to be God with us. It is upon the foundation of Christ that God builds a house for us. It is not a house defined by walls or human expectations. It is a home built upon the promise, hope, and love of our Savior. That home is with us wherever we go (or don't go). It is in the hearts and minds and prayers of our church community, our worship (whether online or in person), and the many creative ways we come together in these times. In this Advent Season, let us prepare our hearts and minds, our community, and our lives to once again welcome God who is with us wherever we go (or don't go).

• During Advent, the Monday Morning Message and Wednesday Time of Prayer Constant Contact emails will be readings from *The Mystery of Holy Night* by Dietrich Bonhoeffer. Each reading will followed by a hymn based musical meditation on that reading.

Bonhoeffer (1906-1945) was a German theologian. In 1933 he helped form the "Confessing Church", breaking away from the Evangelical Church after it added the "Aryan Clause" to its confession. Bonhoeffer is probably most well known for being a part of the plot to assassinate Hiltler. The plan was discovered, and he was arrested in April of 1943. He spent 2 years in prison and in the spring of 1945, he was taken to Flossenburg, an extermination camp and was executed—just 3 weeks before the Americans liberated the camp.

• THE HEART OF CHRISTMAS, a book of devotionals for the Advent Season, by Hank Hanegraaff, is available in the church office. You may also see one of the ushers on Sunday morning and pick one up. The purpose of THE HEART OF CHRISTMAS is to ensure that just as you prepare your home for Christmas, you will likewise prepare your heart.

# The Session met on November 17, 2020 for its regular Stated Meeting. The following are the highlights from that meeting:

- 1. A 'Covenant of Care and Respect For the Leaders of First Presbyterian Church Pastors, Staff, Elders, and Deacons' is being considered for adoption by the Session.
- 2. The Service of Wholeness and Healing scheduled for 11/18/2020 was postponed due to Leighbeing quarantined.
- 3. A funeral policy during the Covid-19 crises was adopted by the Session.
- 4. Action on the use by outside groups of the FPC facilities was postponed until the December Session Meeting.
- 5. Mary Gilreath reported that gift baskets are being prepared for delivery to some or our older members.
- 6. Beth Gaines reported that Hanging of the Greens on 12/2/2020 is still on and Christmas Eve services will take place at 5:00, 7:00, and 9:00 PM with a family-friendly service at 3:00 with animals.
- 7. An amendment to the FPC Child Safety policy was adopted by the Session.
- 8. A contract has been signed with Hunter Public Adjusting to assist us in resolving our roof damage claim with our insurance carrier.
- 9. Paul Green reported that the FPC finances are in good shape through 10/31/2020 and that the 2021 Budget should be ready next month.
- 10. Janet Martin reported that the Personnel Committee plans to prepare updated written job descriptions for all staff.
- 11. The Leigh Jones Installation service is scheduled for 1/10/2021 at the 11:00 AM Service.

### You Will Also Need These Tools...

- sharp scissors
- tape measure (flexible)
- pen or pencil
- approx. 2 yards of narrow ribbon (about 3/8" recommended)
- 1 decorative pearl pin
