

In this season, we are invited in the name of Christ to observe a holy lent, by self-examination and penitence, by prayer and fasting, by works of love, and by reading and meditating on the Word of God.

These words are a part of our traditional "Invitation to Lenten Discipline" that are spoken at our Ash Wednesday worship. Lent is a time of reflection and service, and growing closer to Christ. In our ongoing reflection about how we conduct ourselves, our Session and Deacons have adopted a Covenant of Care and Respect. A Covenant involves promises we make to one another and to God. This Covenant seeks to put into words the principles we are given in Scripture about how to treat one another. The text of the Covenant we adopted is on the next page.

This covenant in not only for the Lenten season. It is for all seasons. But Lent is an excellent time to reflect on the tenants of the covenant as we all turn and return to God and pay careful attention to how God is calling us to live.

The Session has invited our church staff to reflect on and adopt this covenant and I invite everyone in our congregation to consider doing so as well. You might put a copy in your Bible or on your refrigerator. You might snap a picture of it and use it as part of your morning devotion or reading while you are waiting in the doctor's office or to pick your kids up from school.

You could invite a friend or family member or one of our leaders (Session or Deacons) to join you in an accountability group for the season of Lent, where you commit to reflect on and pray about these tenants daily. You might agree to exchange e-mails or texts about your reflection on the covenant. Or to pray for one another daily.

One of my favorite prayer covenants comes from Stan Ott. I have modified it to include our Covenant of Care and Respect. It goes something like this:

Lord, grant (<u>names of friends you are doing this with</u>) and me the grace today to commit our lives to the Lordship of Jesus Christ without reservation, and grant ______ and me further the grace to know your strength and your guidance this day. Grant us the wisdom to learn from the Covenant of Care and Respect that we have committed to and the faithfulness that we may live more fully into that covenant every day. Amen.

Regardless of how you reflect on the covenant or commit to live more fully into it, I invite you to use this Holy Season as a time to consider what it means to pick up our crosses every day, in our words and in our actions. May you have a Holy Lent.

From the Session

The Session met on February 16, 2021 for its regular Stated Meeting. The following are the highlights from that meeting:

1. The Session adopted a 'Covenant of Care and Respect' document recommended by Pastor Leigh.

2. An Easter Egg Hunt in the front courtyard of FPC on 3/28/2021 at 4:00 PM was approved.

3. Vacation Bible School will take place July 26-30 this year.

4. A Worship Committee Task Force was approved to conduct listening sessions and make a recommenda-

tion regarding an Upper Room additional worship service.

- 5. Action was deferred until March on consideration of opening FPC to outside groups.
- 6. Preschool registration began 2/1/2021 and will include a new kindergarten class.
- 7. The FPC insurance carrier has hired an engineer to inspect the FPC roof damage as our FPC-hired Pub-

lic Adjuster seeks to work our an agreeable claim settlement.

8. FPC, HOC, and our Pre-School collectively as one entity are considering an application for a second round PPP Loan.

9. As of 1/31/2021, we have a \$2,542 budget surplus.

10. The Session approved a vacation for Pastor Leigh April 4-11. Andrea Roche will preach on 4/11/2021.

11. The FPC Endowment Committee approved donations to several of our mission partners. Pastor Leigh will deliver the checks.

12. Pastor Leigh's installation service will take place on March 21 at 3:30 PM.
