One: Hear the good news! Who is in a position to condemn? Only Christ, and Christ

died for us, Christ rose for us, Christ reigns in power for us, Christ prays for us.

All: Anyone who is in Christ is a new creation. The old life has gone; a new life has

begun.

One: Friends, believe the good news!

All: In Jesus Christ, we are forgiven.

This is one of my favorite Assurance of Pardons. It sums up the foundation of our faith and how we are made new in the gift of Christ. I like to think of this Assurance of Pardon as something we proclaim every day. There will always be times when we try to put on the old life, but God's mercies are new every morning. Each new day, we are made new in Christ to go out and serve. We often think of Easter as one day, but Easter is every day. We wake up every day and are once again given the gift of life and the gift of life in Christ. In the church year, there is an entire season of Easter that gives us time to reflect on that good news and what it means for our lives. On Easter Sunday we celebrate and affirm that He is Risen! In the season of Easter we give thanks for God's mercies and love that we know in the Resurrection and contemplate how we can live into that mercy and love. A common phrase that is used in the church is "Easter people." The season of Easter is also a time when we can figure out how to live as Easter people. For this season of Easter, I invite us all to reflect on what it means to be Easter people and to seek to live, not just one day, but every day as people who are made new in Christ each and every day.

The Session met on March 16, 2021 for its regular Stated Meeting. The following are the highlights from that meeting:

- 1. A Worship Committee request was approved to upgrade the FPC audio/visual equipment.
- 2. A request by the Hands of Christ Board to host Summer Camps at FPC was approved.
- 3. A Community Resource Center request for a fund driver for baby supplies was approved.
- 4. A Worship Committee request to hold Youth Sunday on 5/2/2021 was approved.
- 5. A decision on allowing outside groups to return to in-person meetings at FPC was postponed for 30 more days.
- 6. The Hands of Christ Budget has been approved and a search is on for a reliable bus.
- 7. The preschool currently has 47 students signed up for the new school year.
- 8. Our Congregational Care Committee is mailing out Easter cards to older members.
- 9. The FPC Pastor Nominating Committee will participate in Leigh's Installation Service on 3/21/2021.
- 10. A Task Force has been appointed to consider returning to an Upper Room Service.
- 11. An Easter Egg Hunt is being planned for 3/28/2021 (Palm Sunday) from 4:00-6:00 PM.
- 12. The Mission Committee reminded the Session that April is Child Abuse Prevention Month.
- 13. The Stewardship Committee reported that both income and expenses are on track and in good shape.
- 14. The Ministry Team appointed to address our roof claim decided to seek competitive roofing bids for the replacement of the Educational Building Roof.
- 15. A report dated 3/3/2021 was received from the Endowment Committee.
- 16. The Personnel Committee is working on updated job descriptions for all staff.
