From the Session

The following are the highlights from the 6/15/2021 Session Meeting:

- 1. New Covid-19 policies were approved by email vote on 5/18/2021.
- 2. The following 2021 Officer Nominating Committee nominees were approved:

Megan Johnson-Session, Karen Russell-Diaconate, Emily Ireland-Youth, Trey Gaines-At Large, and Lois Hill-At Large

- 3. Janet Martin and Robert Sims were appointed commissioners to the 6/12/2021 Cherokee Presbytery Meeting.
- 4. A renewal 6-Month contract with New Hope Janitorial for day and evening cleaning of the Educational Building was approved.
- 5. A \$400,000 Line of Credit with First Bank of Dalton was renewed for 12 months.
- 6. The Diaconate is in the process of implementing a new Shepherding Ministry.
- 7. Hands of Christ students enjoyed a great first week of summer camp.
- 8. Beth Weathersby will no longer serve as co-director of the Preschool as of 6/30/2021 but will continue on the Preschool Board.
- 9. Congregational Care is working with Congregational Life on a refreshment plan for the summer before or after the 10 AM Services.
- 10. A plan to re-start Wednesday Night Suppers after the Covid-19 shutdown is underway.
- 11. Pastor Leigh plans to begin an Inquirer's Class on 6/27/2021.
- 12. Vacation Bible School leaders have been recruited but more volunteers are needed.
- 13. A plan to re-start Friendship Table after the Covid-19 shutdown is underway. We need a coordinator or a coordinator team.
- 14. The bridal room will be painted soon and will double as a prayer room.
- 15. The water damaged sheet rock has been replaced.
- 16. Payments totaling \$56,585.99 for our roof wind claim have been issued by Brotherhood Mutual but a new hail damage claim has been reported.
- 17. The FPC budgeted income and expenses through 5/31/2021 are on track.
- 18. An Endowment Committee Report dated 6/14/2021 was received.
- 19. Job descriptions for all staff are being updated by the Personnel Committee.
- 20. A strong argument can be made that the 'Front Door' of FPC is now our web site and Facebook Page with visits trending up to both.


FPC Hands of Christ




