#### From Stewardship & Finance Committee:

- Pledges Year to Date are at 53% which is slightly above budget.
  - Other giving is down Year to Date but the vast majority typically comes in in November & December.
- Expenses YTD are at 44% which is below budget.
- Our year to Date Net Total is \$12,605 below budget but that is historically very good for this point this year.

# The Session has approved the following recommendation from the Worship Task Force.

The worship task force recommends that the session empower the personnel committee to begin conversations and a search process as soon as possible to identify a musician or musicians who will coordinate and lead music for an informal service to take place in the Upper Room at 9:00 a.m. on Sundays. The task force recommends that our current worship schedule of one service each Sunday in the sanctuary at 10:00 a.m. continue at least through the day before Labor Day, September 5, 2021, to give the personnel committee time to initiate and conduct a search. We acknowledge that we cannot know the timing of the search process, nor its ultimate result.

We give thanks for the hard work of the Worship Task Force as well as the leadership of the Session as, together, we discern the ways God is calling us to worship and serve for the coming year. Our journey of discernment continues and will involve the work and prayers of our Personnel Committee and our Worship Committee as we continue to seek to clarify how we can glorify God through our worship. The Officer Nominating Committee is prayerfully discerning those whom God is calling to be leaders in our congregation. Your suggestions are welcomed.
