

You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your strength, and with all your mind; and your neighbor as yourself. Luke 10:27

What can love do? Paul says if we have all faith, all knowledge, understand all mysteries but do not have love, we have nothing (1 Corinthians 13). This could logically lead us to say that love is everything. If we are going by Paul's description, it seems like love is everything! Love is patient, kind, not boastful, arrogant or rude. Love bears all things, believes all things . . .

These words are likely familiar to many and they set a very high standard for love. But that's how amazing God's love for us is. God so loved the world that God sent Christ to die for us so that we might know the depth of God's love. That love is stronger than our brokenness, than our sin, and even stronger than death itself. God's love overflows in our hearts so that we love God and our neighbor.

Loving God with all our heart, soul, strength, and mind and loving our neighbor as ourselves means being ready to dare. The kind of dare that God places on our hearts is one that invites us to step out of our comfort zones, giving of ourselves, our time, our talents, our prayers, and our financial resources.

For this Fall season, I invite us all to think about how God is daring us to love, to serve, to hope. Is it reaching out to those who are hurting or those who are left out? Is it saying thank you to those who have served? Is it serving by feeding the hungry or sharing our resources with those who have little?

I want to invite you to be a part of loving God and neighbor, through our worship, our service, and our giving. Sunday, October 10, we will dare to love by saying thank you to our soldiers. In worship, we will write thank you cards that will be sent Support Our Troops and then forwarded to deployed soldiers, Sailors, Marines and Airmen.

The next Sunday, we will dare to serve by feeding the hungry of this community. We will meet in the Fellowship Hall at 3:30 to make peanut butter sandwiches and pack brown bag meals for the homeless. Our partners at Good Neighbor Homeless Shelter will be joining us to help us deliver those meals to the homeless. Sunday, October 24, we will dare to hope, by offering our Stewardship pledge cards and words of hope for our community.

This congregation loves in amazing ways. We love God with our heart, soul, strength, and mind. That love overflows as we share God's love with our neighbors. This congregation gives very generously so that we can share God's love with our community and beyond. In this Stewardship season, as we pray about next year, let us see what love can do and dare.




Dare to Serve Mission Project October 17th, 3:30 PM Fellowship Hall
