Have you ever thought about the movement of water? From the way it laps on the shore, to gentle waves, to the powerful waves of the ocean, the flow of water can be beautiful, soothing, and powerful. I recall a certain kayaking trip down the Etowah river this Fall with the youth when I got to know the waters of that river very well! I got to know some rocks along the river also. Along the Etowah, there's a beautiful cold spring that you can stop and see as you kayak down the river. The water bubbles up from the spring, fills the small area where it originates until it is full to the brim, and then overflows into other pools all around.

Have you ever thought of or experienced grace in the same way? The scriptures for Lent this year are filled with parables and promises of God's abundant and expansive grace. There is nothing we have done to earn God's grace or deserve it and yet, like water flowing out from the spring, it spills over. It has a ripple effect that makes it more expansive the more it is offered. It has the power to shape us, transform us and guide us. With this in mind our Lenten theme for 2022 is "Full to the Brim: An Expansive Lent."

We are invited to experience a radically different Lent this year, where we recognize what keeps us from being our authentic selves and embrace God's grace which spills over in and through our hearts and lives. We will confront what keeps us from truly knowing Christ and the grace He offers, touching on topics such as our views on societal scarcity contrasted with God's abundance that is full to the brim. This Lent, we are all invited to experience the love of God that lavishes us, spills over us and flows around and through us.

There are many ways to immerse ourselves in God's expansive grace this Lent. It begins with Ash Wednesday, on March 2nd at 6:30. With ashes, we acknowledge and mourn our sin and our mortality, and we begin the journey of opening our minds and hearts to Christ. Each Sunday of Lent, worship will invite us to let go of an aspect of our lives that hinders our path to God and to embrace more fully the love and grace we know in Christ. There is a Full to the Brim daily devotion book that you may pick up in the front office and there will be daily readings on Facebook. Our children and youth will be reflecting on God's overflowing grace in Sunday school. There will be a Wednesday Night Zoom Study starting March 9 and continuing through April 13. For this study, will meet online at 7:30 p.m. and discuss "The Lord's Prayer: The Meaning and Power of the Prayer Jesus Taught," by the Rev. Adam Hamilton.

During this Lenten Season may each of us be reminded to live fully into the grace and hope we know in Christ as we express both our grief and gratitude. May we also learn to trust fully that we belong to God, just as we are. As we grow in that understanding may we offer the grace that we have received to others so that others can experience the love, grace and mercy of our God. Finally, may we discover what it means to live into the expansive life that God envisions and intends for us all.

Lenten Wreath

We are all familiar with the rich worship visuals of Advent. Chrismons, wreaths, live greenery, and poinsettias fill our Sanctuary each week. For most of us, the Advent Wreath lighting is a huge part of that visual experience.

In searching for ways to incorporate visuals for Lent, we came across the Lenten Wreath. This wreath will be made of dried vines and thorns and will contain 5 purple candles with the Christ Candle in the middle. On the first Sunday in Lent all the candles will be lighted and one will then be extinguished. On the following Sundays, only the remaining candles are lighted with one being extinguished each Sunday until Good Friday when only the Christ Candle is burning. At that service, it too is extinguished, leaving us in darkness.

On Easter Sunday, the Christ Candle is lighted again and fresh flowers will be added to the wreath of thorns, reminding all of us of the new life we all have in Christ.
