#### **Praising God Throughout Our Lives**

"Sing Praises to the Lord, O you his faithful ones, and give thanks to his holy name." (Psalm 30:4)

It is often said that the seasons of the church year reflect our lives. There are times of waiting and darkness like Advent, times of joy when we know Christ has come to be with us like Christmas. There are times of repentance such as Lent and times of new life and resurrection. There are times when we are profoundly touched by the power of the Spirit (Pentecost) and times when we turn to our ancestors in the faith for strength and courage (Reformation Sunday).

We are now in the Season of Easter, which is a time for us to celebrate and live into the promises of the Resurrection. This is a time to join the chorus of all creation as we sing our praises to our God. But even in the season of Easter, we have many different seasons in our lives. That truth reminds me of Psalm 30, which is a psalm of praise, but recognizes that there are many different moments in our lives and different ways to praise. We sing praises; we cry to God; we weep; we are dismayed; we plead with God. Ultimately, though, our entire lives are lived in praise of our God.

There is a prayer that is found in our Episcopalian brothers and sisters Book of Common Prayer that says: "No one is far from you, O God. We come to you in joy - mindful of the burdens we carry, the hurts and sorrows we have. We come together in gladness - never forgetting God's love. We come together with praise - for each other and those who assist us on this journey. No one is far from you, O God, and we call upon your power in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit". This prayer speaks our praises while acknowledging the burdens, the sorrows, the hurts, and the power of the love that sustains us all. In this season of Easter, regardless of what season we find ourselves in, let us all find ways to praise God.

1. A request to add small bread pieces and a grape juice chalice as another option to communion pods on 5/1/2022 (Youth Sunday) was approved.

- 3. Vacation Bible School this year will be 6/27-7/1 from 9:00 AM until 12:00 Noon.
- 4. Friendship Table is expected to start back up before 5/31/2022.
- 5. The Bride's Room at FPC will also be available as a Prayer Room.
- 6. Replacement HVAC Units are expected to be installed by July in conjunction with the FPC roof claim.
- 7. Pledge receipts were at 28% of the amounts pledged at the 25% point (3/31/2022) of the calendar year.
- 8. The John Panter Ukraine Fund has reached \$11,000 and contributions are still being accepted.
