### The Heart of Worship

Then on that day, David first appointed the singing of praises to the Lord . . . Worship the Lord in holy splendor; tremble before him, all the earth . . Then all the people said, 'Amen!' and praised the Lord.

1 Chronicles 16

From the beginning of time, all creation has found ways to worship God. Our Scriptures tell of moments from Noah and his family lifting their prayers, to Sarah's laughter, to Jacob's placing stones to mark a holy moment. 1 Chronicles tells of the ways David led the people to worship. Jesus took time to go off by himself to pray and led his disciples in times of prayer and thanksgiving. The very first Easter worship service took place right outside the tomb with the disciples.


Worship occurs in many times and ways and places, but, as David recognized, there is something very important, even essential, about regular, organized, communal worship. Why is regular, organized, communal worship important? What is the purpose of such worship and how does it shape us? What form should it take?

Contemporary Christian singer Matt Redmond has a song entitled "The Heart of Worship." It says, "I'm comin' back to the heart of worship; And it's all about You; It's all about You, Jesus." Jesus is indeed the heart of worship, but what does that mean about our style of worship, the music we choose, who does what, or even the Sacraments? What does Scripture say about worship and what does our denomination say about worship?

For the month of June, we will be considering such questions in Sunday morning worship. I invite you to share any questions you have about worship, by email, text, or call the church office. I will use those questions to shape our reflection. Each Sunday, there will be slips of paper available that you can pick up and write a question on and return in the offering plates.

I look forward to learning and growing as, together, we consider the heart of worship for the month of June.

### **Be Aware**

Sadly, these days, scams are very common. Scammers are very clever about ways to get access to your money. One very common way is to ask you to purchase gift cards and send them the number off the card or a picture of it

No one from our congregation or staff will ever ask you to purchase gift cards via text or email. If you receive a text or email claiming to be anyone from our staff requesting gift cards or financial support it is a scam.

Also, scammers will send emails claiming to be from companies like Amazon, Norton Anti-Virus, Geek Squad, or your phone company, or tech support for Apple or Microsoft, and ask you to call them. Do not click on links in emails or call the number provided. Instead, find the number of the company and call them directly and ask if a representative has contacted you. In addition, people may call and claim to be a family member needing help.


