At one time or another, all of us have struggled with issues related to the cares of the world and the challenge of living faithfully into God's abundant love for us. These issues include our attitudes and practices about finances, saving, and spending. Our relationship with Christ and our spiritual well-being are impacted by those attitudes and practices. Yet, they are often uncomfortable to consider, reflect on, or talk about.

For some, such matters are considered private. While our financial giving to God is between us and God, the practice of faithful stewardship, our attitudes and practices of giving, and living into God's abundant love is of the greatest importance to our discipleship. This is why over the next four weeks, we will be spending time in worship and reflection on *Abundance: Discovering Joy Through Simplicity and Generosity.* During this time we will explore what the Bible teaches us about attitudes and practices relating to our financial resources. We will pray together and learn about how our management of our resources shapes our faith and how our faith shapes our management of our resources.

Each week, we will offer some practical tools that can be used as we all seek to grow in faith. At the conclusion of that time, we will have the opportunity to make personal commitments of our offerings to God through our church in the coming year. We will consecrate these commitments in worship on Oct. 30th. I hope you will join us in the coming weeks as we consider what it means to live into God's Abundance and truly experience simplicity, generosity and joy.


