

Walking With God

"Teach me your way, Lord, so that I can walk in your truth." Psalm 86:11

Psalm 86 is one of my favorite psalms. It names our need to draw closer to God and the fact that we often struggle to do so. It is cry, a confession, a plea, a prayer, and a reminder. This Lenten season we once again turn to God, both admitting our brokenness, and asking for God to help us to draw near to our Savior once again. The first thing Jesus says to his disciples is, "Come, follow me." The Greek word that Jesus uses actually means "walk with me." In the first letter of John, we are told that as we follow Jesus, we walk in the light, and Paul reminds us that we walk by faith. This Lent, we have an opportunity to walk more closely with Christ through our study of Adam Hamilton's *The Walk*. Over the weeks of this season, we will be reflecting on five simple practices that Jesus' followers have always pursued as they seek to walk with him. This is not an exhaustive list, but these five are foundational. They are all essential parts of a life of discipleship. They are five practices that we can all benefit from focusing on, regardless of our age or stage. By focusing on these, we can strengthen our discipleship muscles and grow in faith this Lenten season. These practices are: Worship and Prayer; Study - The Importance of Listening and Paying Attention; Serve; Give; Share. Each Sunday, we will focus on one of these practices and concrete ways that we can focus on them in our lives. Hamilton observes: "When pursued daily, these practices will increase your spiritual health, deepen your faith, make you more aware of God's presence, and help you live the Christian life." This Lent, let us all seek to walk more closely with Christ and learn God's ways.

That same Essential Practice will be the focus of worship and of opportunities to live out that practice in our daily lives. This study includes video from Hamilton as well as an optional participant's guide which can be purchased on Amazon or Christanbook.com. If you need assistance purchasing a book (either financial or technical), contact Pastor Leigh or Jean Gilliland. This study focuses our hearts and lives on spiritual practices that will help us walk closer with God in the holy season of Lent.

The Friendship Table is our mission to provide a free hot meal to anyone in the community who needs a meal and fellowship. Friendship Table volunteers serve this meal every Tuesday evening from 6 to 7 PM in the church's Fellowship Hall. 
