

## *Keep vigilant watch over your heart; that's where life starts.* Proverbs 4:23 The Message

Did you know that August 7th-13th is National Simplify Your Life Week? This week originated as an addition to the concept of Spring Cleaning. The thinking is that once you finally finish Spring Cleaning (which I may be wrapping up by August), the next thing to focus on is simplifying. There are many different ways to simplify and it is not always about removing physical clutter out of your life.

We can simplify our schedules, our practices, our priorities. It is also an invitation to evaluate what is really important and then focus on that, rather than ten thousand things all at once. As Fall approaches, the church may begin looking at programming or schedules, small groups or activities. Evaluating all these opportunities is an essential part of ministry, especially these days when ministry can look very different with each passing season. But, first, we need to simplify and look again at the heart of the matter - our calling for ministry.

Beth Daniel, of the Ministry Collaborative puts it this way:

In this time of year, we may be tempted to zoom in on the nuts and bolts of planning and programming, trying to somehow manage everything that comes with it. However as we think about what does and doesn't deserve our attention in this season, it seems to me that we must include an honest look at our own faith, and call, and gifts. Take time to reflect on your faith, your call, and your unique God-given gifts. Don't rush past the simple questions but engage and explore them and remember and (re)discover the What and Why of your vocation.

As we seek to get to the heart of the matter, we can ask questions like: What do I believe? Why do I serve? What are my unique gifts? What are my passions? How will I lean into my faith, call, and gifts this year?

In this time of year the world tells us that we need to be planning, scheduling, or adding, but first we need to get to the heart of our common calling. That is where life starts.
