

## Following are the highlights from the 8/15/2023 Session Meeting:

1. Garey Wilkins was hired for Janitorial Services under a trial period on the recommendation of the Personnel Committee and the Pre-School Board. Garey's duties will extend to the 2nd Floor Educational Building and 'as needed' for other functions/activities.

2. Rich Gaffoglio reported that Lindsay Scoggins has resigned as Pre-School Director and Jennifer Graves has been hired to replace Lindsay. Kerri Vessels has been hired as a kindergarten teacher.

3. Sonya Noble has agreed to serve a 1-Year Term on the Pre-School Board.

4. Suzanne Collins reported that a program is being planned on advance directives/wills.

5. Jean Gilliland reported that Sunday School will resume 9/10/2023 with a kickoff event.

6. Paul Green provided the Session with a list of 'issues' that include (a) Education Building HVAC, and (b) Security System.

7. Mark Bridges reported that FPC is in good financial shape but with two clouds on the horizon: Education Building HVAC replacement and Security System replacement.

8. The Session approved the 12 Month renewal of our FNB of Dalton Line of Credit.

9. The Fall Stewardship will begin 10/1/2023 with dedication Sunday on 10/15/2023.

10. Peter Olson reported from the Endowment Committee that 2022 Interest of \$10,043 is payable in 2023 and is available for Missions.

11. Robert Sims reported and the Session approved the terms of call for Jim Stanley (Director of Music) and Fred Drifmeyer (Organist/Accompanist).

12. Pastor Leigh announced a Session Visioning Retreat on 11/4/2023. The incoming class of new officers will be examined at the 9/19/2023 Session Meeting.
