# Sing to God a new song, for God has done marvelous things. Let the floods clap their hands; let the hills sing together for joy. Psalm 98



Have you ever thought of the creation story in Genesis 1 as a symphony of joy? It is. The very rhythm of the words is a song of praise, but all that God creates is too. We are certainly included in creation. Our lives should be a proclamation of praise and joy for our God.

The church is a community of joy. In Philippians, Paul writes that he thanks God every time he remembers the community, constantly praying with joy in every one of his prayers for all of them. Even in challenging times, Paul says, "I will continue to rejoice." The community helps us know and experience the true source of joy, Christ Jesus, so that we can rejoice in all circumstances.

You may have heard me talk about the difference between joy and happiness. Happiness is circumstantial and there are many times in our lives when we are sad, angry, frustrated, devastated, or all of the above. But, joy is the experience of knowing Christ and of knowing him in and through his body, this community.

This community has seen many changes over the past few years, but we are blessed to be able to come together for joy as the body of Christ. In doing so, we recognize that we have much to celebrate about the future.

Our Stewardship theme this year, Together for Joy, names the truth that we are called to join the praise of creation and live lives of joy. We do so, not just in worship, but in all that we do. How can we come together for joy for the coming year? Our time, talents, and resources, as well as our prayers and commitment all play an essential part of what it means to come together for joy.

I join our Stewardship and Finance Committee in inviting us all to pray for our congregation. Let us seek God's guidance as we reflect on the ministry God is calling us to for the coming year and the part each of us is to play in that ministry. As you do so, consider praying this prayer:

Almighty God, for you the floods clap, for you the hills sing. We come together for joy in this season so that we might lift our praise and thanks to you. As we consider our giving and gratitude, show us how to use our resources to join the great chorus of creation and glorify you. Amen

Our FPC Staff gathered in September for our first official staff meeting for the Fall. We celebrated and welcomed new staff members and prayed to-


