Rejoice always, pray without ceasing, give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you. 1 Thessalonians 5:16-18

Paul's words about prayer are some of my favorite in Scripture. Paul reminds us of the centrality of prayer for all our lives and especially for our relationship with God. One of the most central and important aspects of Christian living is the practice of prayer. This November, I invite everyone to take time to focus on this practice. How can we grow in our prayer practices and in our relationship with God?

Dr. Martha Moore-Keish, professor at Columbia Theological Seminary and author of Christian Prayer For Today will begin the conversation on November 12th at a potluck luncheon after worship. Our Session has been studying this book this past year and Dr. Moore-Keish has agreed to come and speak with our entire congregation about how everyone can grow in our understanding and practice of prayer. Her book provides fresh help for understanding and revitalizing prayer life, challenges readers to engage all senses while in prayer, and invites us to grow in our understanding of this chief exercise of faith.

Reading the book in anticipation of this visit is not necessary, but if you wish to do so copies are available for purchase on Amazon and Christianbook or can be borrowed from the Church Office. As we look toward the holy Season of Advent, there is no better way to spend the time before Advent than to focus on how, why, and when we pray and how prayer invites us into a deeper relationship with our Savior.

Giving Thanks For Our Leaders


