#### The Awe of Pentecost

May is a month of transitions. Spring is turning to summer, school is drawing to a close, graduations are taking place, and the days of procrastinating on yard work because it's not quite necessary are over! Plans for the summer shift from being plans to being a reality and the longer days make for wonderful evenings to go for a walk, or have a cook-out, or sit and enjoy the beauty of creation for a bit longer.

May is also the time we shift in the church seasons from the season of Easter, to Pentecost. For six weeks, we have celebrated the Resurrection and considered what it means to live as Easter people. Fifty days after Easter, Pentecost (meaning fifty days) arrives with the rush of a violent wind and tongues as of fire (Acts 2). On Pentecost Sunday, Christians around the world celebrate the formation of the church when the Holy Spirit called people into community as Christ's body. Though it may not be as well-known as other "high, holy days" such as Christmas or Easter, Pentecost is a tremendous day in church history.

Theologian Willie James Jennings asserts: "Only the gracious work of God in creation matches this moment of prevenient grace." He's not alone in this conviction; some theologians describe Pentecost as the Church's birthday. Others describe it as a "big bang" that brought the Church into being, for just as God's Spirit came rushing into the world over the waters of creation, in Acts 2, God's Spirit rushes into the world to gather and transform God's people.

Far too often, we think of Pentecost as simply a day when we wear red to worship. But, it is an opportunity to immerse ourselves in awe as we consider the power of the Spirit in our church and in our lives. If we are willing to be amazed, Pentecost is one of the most awe-inspiring days in our Christian calendar. If we are willing to be transformed, it is an opportunity to be renewed in energy and faithfulness toward the work of God's kingdom on earth.

For May 19th, I invite everyone to wear red to celebrate this holy day, but let's also come with open and willing hearts that we may see and experience anew the awesome power of the Spirit. For the entire month of May and into the summer, let us all lift prayers in thanksgiving for the gift of the Spirit and seek to see and celebrate the many ways the Spirit is blowing in our midst.

At its meeting on April 16, the FPC Session:
