Beyond "Beyond the Bumper Sticker"

Tune your ears to the world of Wisdom; set your heart on a life of Understanding. That's right—if you make Insight your priority, and won't take no for an answer, Searching for it like a prospector panning for gold, like an adventurer on a treasure hunt, Believe me, before you know it Fear-of-God will be yours; you'll have come upon the Knowledge of God. (Proverbs 2:1-5, The Message)

Our summer sermon series, *Beyond the Bumper Sticker*, is drawing to a close, but are there ways we can live into the series beyond the month of July? We can always keep an eye out for a clever bumper sticker! But, we can also prayerfully seek to model some of the practices we reflected on in the past month.

We can continue to look beyond the one line or even one passage. There is a wealth of depth in just a single line of God's Word, but there's also more beyond any one line. Next time you are praying about or reflecting on a line of Scripture or even a passage, consider how you might look beyond it. What are the passages that come before and after? Around when was the book written and by whom and for whom? What were the circumstances around the writing of the book? How are those circumstances similar to or different from our circumstances today?

These insights can help us consider Scripture from a broader perspective and learn more about how God's Word speaks to us today. As our Fall ministries begin to roll out, there are many ways to continue to tune our ears to God's wisdom - from Adult small groups to our children's ministries to our Fall Retreat, from worship to service, I invite all of us to find ways to go beyond and look deeper into God's word and will for our lives.



We had a great time at the Montreat Middle School Conference at Maryville College July 17-21. We explored the theme of "In the Middle of it All," enjoyed being to-


