Gratitude

Psalm 107:1-3: "Oh give thanks to the LORD, for He is good, for His steadfast love endures forever!"

Some people in my family are already listening to Christmas songs and watching Hallmark Christmas Movies (Chris, Ben and Amelia). I, however, am holding the line in the Jones family - we should not think about Christmas until after Thanksgiving! I may never change my mind about that, but I have changed my mind about how we think about Thanksgiving. Thanksgiving should be a daily practice, rather than a day or season of the year. The psalmist says simply: Give thanks to the Lord. Nowhere does Scripture say, "Give thanks once a year."

This does not mean Thanksgiving isn't a wonderful time to lift extra prayers of thanks and praise, but the practice of thanksgiving, should be a daily discipline. I use the word discipline to help us remember its roots - it comes from the word disciple, which means learner. We are learners and followers of Christ if we practice disciplines. Those disciplines include giving of time, talents, and treasure to Christ, committed prayer and Bible study and thanksgiving. So, whether you have been singing Christmas carols all year round, or you wait until the week before Christmas, may this Thanksgiving be a time of thanks and praise and an opportunity to examine our daily practices.

How can we give thanks every single day? I want to especially take time to give thanks this month for all the spiritual leaders in our congregation and particularly for those who serve as Ruling Elders and Deacons. These are people who, in their walk with Christ, are called to serve and grow as disciples by giving their time, talent, and treasure as spiritual leaders in our congregation. I am thankful for all who serve. We remember this month, too, those who are rotating off from active leadership and those who are rotating on. If you have a moment, lift a prayer of thanksgiving for all our leaders and share your thanks with them. And I invite us all to daily give thanks to God for all God's goodness in our lives.

From the Session:


At its stated meeting for October the FPC Session:
