

#### ALL Glory, Laud and Honor?

This is the title of a familiar Palm Sunday hymn. As we are singing our way through Lent and Easter, we are quickly making our way to lifting our voices and joining generations of the faithful marking Jesus' triumphant entry into Jerusalem with songs on Palm Sunday. But, like all the generations before us, there are moments when we sing God's praises and then moments when we turn away from God and God's good intentions for our lives.

Palm Sunday begins Holy Week, the most sacred time in the church year and the time we remember how quickly we go from singing praises to crying out "Crucify Him." Holy Week is a week of contradictions. How can we sing All Glory, Laud and Honor, but then turn away from Christ, failing to truly honor him as our King?

We often turn away in subtle ways, arranging our priorities away from Christ, shifting discipleship to the bottom of our to-do-list or allowing fear to dictate our choices and actions. Holy Week is a time to slow down and to carefully consider what our choices and actions say about our faith and to consider all that Christ does for us in spite of our brokenness.

I invite us all to slow down for Holy Week. Take each day and be deliberate about prayer, Scripture, acts of service, and giving. What does it mean to offer God ALL glory, laud, and honor? How can we do so with our lives? How do we falter in our attempts to do so? Let us also consider our gratitude for God's amazing grace. Do we live lives of gratitude? Do we extend that grace to others, not because they deserve it, but because Christ died for all of us so that we might know that grace?

These are questions for Holy Week and it is not really Holy Week unless we stop to consider such questions. We cannot go straight from Palm Sunday to Easter, for if we try to do so, Easter is but a pale reflection of its true meaning. I invite us all to slow down and wrestle with the questions of Holy Week and join us for worship on Maundy Thursday (6:00 PM) and/or Good Friday (Noon, Trinity UMC). Then, together, we can truly rejoice in the Resurrection.




## **Blessing Bag Collection**
