Faithful Living

Only fear the Lord, and serve him faithfully with all your heart; for consider what great things he has done for you. 1 Samuel 12:24

Samuel was one of Israel's greatest prophets, and as he was preparing to leave this earth, he offered wisdom to the people. They had not served the Lord faithfully, but instead had forgotten God and turned to the ways of the world, placing their hope and trust in the powers and principalities, in politics (they advocated for a king even though Samuel insisted that God was their only king) and in the armies of a worldly king.

So Samuel's last advice for them was that they should honor (fear) the Lord and serve God faithfully, always bringing to mind the great things God had done for them. These are wise words for every generation. But every generation struggles with what it looks like to serve God faithfully. We have the BEST possible guide to help us understand what faithful living looks like, in Scripture, but especially in the life and death and resurrection of Christ.

Yet, we still struggle. For the last weeks of summer and as we look toward settling into Fall, I invite us all to prayerfully consider what faithful living looks like for our lives today. In worship, the focus each Sunday will be different reflections on faithful living. Also consider joining a Bible study (Tuesdays at noon or the once a month study on Thursday mornings), Sunday school class, or join the choir or bell choir as they resume. Come to Monday prayer time or develop a new prayer practice. Ask God what faithful living looks like for you and for our congregation and pray about it.

Let us make this August a time to learn and grow as disciples and to continue to seek to live faithfully, honoring and serving God with all our heart.
